#### 1. Call to Order

## 4. Principal's Action Items / Info. Update

- Discussed many of the ongoing activities at the school. She is very impressed by involvement of the school committee.
- Spring concert will be held on May 16 in the evening and May 17 in the morning. Bands and choirs will perform.
- Announced that Mme. Guerin is retiring at the end of this year.
- Staffing activities are ongoing:
  - o Hired a new music teacher (Mr Pretty, currently at Avalon)
  - o Grade 8 MFI being introduced which means the addition of another ½ time position. Mrs Tinney will become full-time to make this position up.

- With the introduction of full day kindergarten, there will be 3 ECE positions to fill (one
  of these must have their French qualification as SK will operate half English/half
  French). Two of these positions will also cover the "extended day program".
- Both a City of Ottawa before and after school program (grades 1-6) and an OCDSB extended day program (JK to grade 6) will operate out of the school. These will be separate programs and parents will need to choose which one they want to use.
- Kindergarten information night is scheduled for May 15 2013
- EQAO letter to be sent home to parents this week. Testing will take place from May 27-June 6
- A parent volunteer breakfast has been organized for Tuesday June 18 from 7:45-8:45
- Christine, Lisa P, Mrs Morris and Mme Learned attended a conference on May 3 for the safe and inclusive schools program. The topic was bullying and they were able to disucss options to tie into the school improvement plan.
- Incoming grade 5 studesnts from Convent Glen and Forest Valley will be coming in for an orientation session.
- A Midsummer's Night's Dream will be performed for the students this month.
- Class structures for next year have not yet been finalized.

## 5. Vice-Principal's Report

- School travel planning survey has been repeated and results to be submitted to Wallace.
- Ongoing assemblies where students are recognized for their participation in activities.
- Recently read the story "How Full is your Bucket? For Kids" and a bulletin board has been set up "drops in the bucket"
- HL hosted a badminton tournament; teams were very successful this year.
